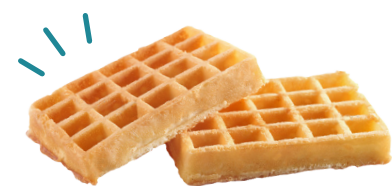
He painted classical themes and situations in a very quirky humorous and innovating way.

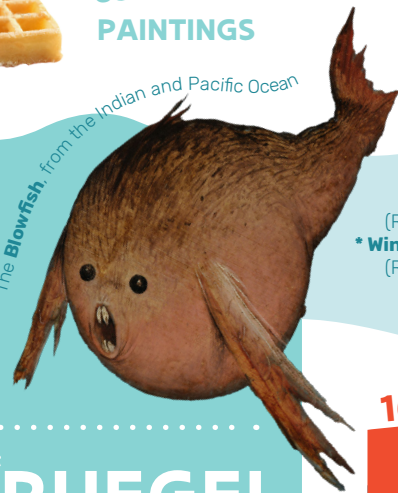
### BREUGELIAANS
